This testimony is documented in my book titled: ***Rescued From Destruction.***

In Hebrews 13: 8, the Bible says: ***Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and today, and forever.*** Jesus has not changed. His power is still the same. He is still doing today what He did in the Bible days!

So, as you read with me in this book, some of the healing miracles that took place during the earthly ministry of Jesus, I want you to turn your faith loose to the Lord. Read these scriptures over and over again. Read these healing miracles over and over again. Then, believe God for your own healing and it shall be established!

Please be aware that nothing is too difficult for God, not even your own case. Assuredly, your situation shall turn to you for a testimony (Luke 21:13)!

With faith in God's Word, therefore, let's go as you read with me right now ***The Healing Ministry Of Jesus Christ.***

May you be richly blessed as you read!

CHAPTER ONE

HEALING OF INDIVIDUALS

In Matthew 8:1-4, Jesus healed a man with leprosy. This healing was also recorded in the Books of Mark 1:40-44 and Luke 5:12-14:

When he was come down from the mountain, great multitudes followed him.

And, behold, there came a leper and worshipped him, saying, Lord, if you will, you can make me clean.

And Jesus put forth his hand, and touched him, saying, I will; be you clean. And immediately his leprosy was cleansed.

And Jesus said to him, See you tell no man; but go your way, show yourself to the priest, and offer the gift that Moses commanded, for a testimony to them.

Jesus put forth His hand and touched this man. The same way, as you read these healing scriptures right now, He is touching you right there where you are, and He is effecting cleansing in your physical body in the name of Jesus.

In Luke 7:1-10, Jesus healed the Roman Centurion's servant; this account is also documented in Matthew 8:5-13:

Now when he had ended all his sayings in the audience of the people, he entered into Capernaum.

And a certain centurion's servant, who was dear to him, was sick, and ready to die.

And when he heard of Jesus, he sent to him the elders of the Jews, beseeching him that he would come and heal his servant.

Then Jesus went with them. And when he was now not far from the house, the centurion sent friends to him, saying to him, Lord, trouble not thyself: for I am not worthy that you should enter unto my roof:

Neither thought I myself worthy to come to you: but say in a word, and my servant shall be healed.

For I also am a man set under authority, having under me soldiers, and I say to one, Go, and he goes; and to another, Come, and he comes; and to

my servant, Do this, and he does it.

When Jesus heard these things, he marveled at him, and turned him about, and said to the people that followed him, I say to you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel.

And they that were sent, returning to the house, found the servant whole that had been sick.

The same Jesus that healed the servant of the Centurion who was sick and ready to die, that same Jesus is making you whole right now. It doesn't matter how terrible that sickness might be in your body, God will reverse the situation in your favour.

In Mark 1:30-31, **Jesus healed Peter's mother-in-law.**

This account is also recorded in Matthew 8:14-15 & Luke 4:38-39:

But Simon's wife's mother lay sick of a fever, and immediately they tell him of her.

And Jesus came and took her by the hand, and lifted her up; and immediately the fever left her, and she ministered to them.

Right there where you are, Jesus is also lifting you by the hand. Expect an instantaneous miracle.

In Luke 8:27-39, two men were possessed with the devil and Jesus healed them. This account is also recorded in Matthew 8:28-34 & Mark 5:1-15 thus:

And when he went forth to land, there met him out of the city a certain man, which had devils long time, and wore no clothes, neither stayed in any house, but in the tombs.

When he saw Jesus, he cried out, and fell down before him, and with a loud voice said, What have I to do with you, Jesus, you Son of God most high? I beseech you, torment me not.

(For Jesus had commanded the unclean spirit to come out of the man. For oftentimes it had caught him: and he was kept bound with chains and in fetters; and he break the bands, and was driven of the devil into the wilderness.)

And Jesus asked him, saying, What is your name? And he said, Legion: because many devils were entered into him.

And they sought him that he would not command them to go out into the deep.

And there was there an herd of many swine feeding on the mountain: and they sought him that he would suffer them to enter into them. And Jesus suffered them.

Then went the devils out of the man, and entered into the swine: and the herd ran violently down a steep place into the lake, and were choked.

When they that fed them saw what was done, they fled, and went and told it in the city and in the country.

Jesus drove out the legion of devils from the possessed man. The same way, I see Him driving out that evil sickness and disease that has been tormenting your body, thereby establishing your liberty.

In Matthew 9:2-7, there was a man with palsy that Jesus healed. This account is also recorded in Mark 2:3-12 & Luke 5:18-26:

And, behold, they brought to him a man sick of the palsy, lying on a bed: and Jesus seeing their faith said to the sick of the palsy; Son, be of good cheer; your sins are forgiven you.

And, behold, certain of the scribes said within themselves, This man blasphemeth.

And Jesus knowing their thoughts said, Why think ye evil in your hearts?

For which one is easier, to say, Your sins be forgiven you; or to say, Arise, and walk?

But that ye may know that the Son of man has power on earth to forgive sins, (then said he to the sick of the palsy,) Arise, take up your bed, and go to your house.

And he arose, and departed to his house.

Right there where you are, let there be faith in your heart. When Jesus sees your faith, He will establish your desired miracle. He said to the sick man, "Arise, take up your bed and go to your house." The same way I prophesy to you right now, "Arise from that bed of affliction and begin to celebrate your liberty."

In Mark 5:25-34, there was a woman that was bleeding that was miraculously healed. This account is also recorded in Matthew 9:20-22 & Luke 8:43-48:

And a certain woman, which had an issue of blood twelve years,

And had suffered many things of many physicians, and had spent all that she had, and was nothing bettered, but rather grew worse,

When she had heard of Jesus, came in the press behind, and touched his garment.

For she said, If I may touch but his clothes, I shall be whole.

And straightway the fountain of her blood was dried up; and she felt in her body that she was healed of that plague...

And Jesus said to her, Daughter, your faith has made you whole; go in peace, and be whole from your plague.

The same way, it doesn't matter for how long that situation has been in your body: this woman had this bleeding for 12 years and her situation was growing worse, but the moment she touched Jesus by faith, she was made whole. It doesn't matter for how long you have been in that situation, stretch forth your faith right now and Jesus will establish your wholeness.

In Matthew 9:27-31, there were two blind men that Jesus healed:

And when Jesus departed thence, two blind men followed him, crying, and saying, You son of David, have mercy on us.

And when he was come into the house, the blind men came to him: and Jesus said to them, Believe you that I am able to do this? They said to him, Yes, Lord.

Then touched he their eyes, saying, According to your faith be it unto you.

And their eyes were opened; and Jesus straightway charged them, saying, See that no man know it.

But they, when they were departed, spread abroad his fame in all the country.

Yes, Jesus touched their eyes, the same way right there where you are, He is touching you and according to your faith, it shall also be delivered unto you.

In Matthew 9:32-33, there was a man that was dumb and devil-possessed that Jesus healed.

As they went out, behold, they brought to him a dumb man possessed with a devil.

And when the devil was cast out, the dumb spake: and the multitudes marveled, saying, It was never so seen in Israel.

God will do something marvellous in your life that people will begin to celebrate and testify of the hand of God upon your life.

In Mark 3:1-5, there was a man with a withered hand and Jesus healed him. This account is also documented in Matthew 12:10-13 & Luke 6 beginning from verse 6:

And he entered again into the synagogue; and there was a man there which had a withered hand.

And they watched him, whether Jesus would heal him on the sabbath day; that they might accuse him.

And Jesus said to the man which had the withered hand, Stand forth.

And he said to them, Is it lawful to do good on the sabbath days, or to do evil? to save life, or to kill? But they held their peace.

And when he had looked around on them with anger, being grieved for the hardness of their hearts, he said to the man, Stretch forth your hand. And he stretched it out: and his hand was restored whole as the other.

God is bringing restoration your way in the name of Jesus Christ.

In Luke 11:14, there was a man that was blind, dumb and devil-possessed that Jesus liberated. This miracle is also documented in Matthew 12:22-23 which says:

And he was casting out a devil, and it was dumb.

And it came to pass, when the devil was gone out, the dumb spake; and the people wondered.

Oh! What a miraculous thing. This man's status was changed for the better. The same way, God is changing your status miraculously, as you read with me by faith these healing miracles that Jesus performed.

In Matthew 15:21-28, there was a Canaanite woman's daughter that was miraculously healed. This miracle is also recorded in Mark 7:24-30.

And, behold, a woman of Canaan came out of the same coasts, and cried to Jesus, saying, Have mercy on me, O Lord, you son of David; my daughter is grievously vexed with a devil...

Then came she and worshipped Jesus saying, Lord, help me.

Vs 28:

Then Jesus answered and said to her, O woman, great is your faith: be it unto you even as you will. And her daughter was made whole from that very hour.

Oh! What a merciful Jesus! His mercy will prevail in your situation right now. Put your faith on the line like this woman did, and your miracle shall be

established.

In Matthew 17:14-21, there was a boy with a devil that Jesus healed. This miracle is also recorded in Mark 9:17-29 and Luke 9:38-43.

And Jesus rebuked the devil; and he departed out of him: and the child was cured from that very hour.

Even children enjoyed the healing ministry of Jesus Christ. This child was cured. The same way, it doesn't matter whether you are a child, an adult or an elderly person reading these scriptures right now, you also shall be miraculously cured by the power of God.

In Mark 10:46-52, blind Bartimaeus was miraculously healed. This account is also recorded in Matthew 20:29-34 and Luke 18:35-43:

And they came to Jericho: and as he went out of Jericho with his disciples and a great number of people, blind Bartimaeus, the son of Timaeus, sat by the highway side begging.

And when he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to cry out, and to say, Jesus, you son of David, have mercy on me.

And many charged him that he should hold his peace: but he cried the more and a great deal, saying You son of David, have mercy on me.

And Jesus stood still, and commanded him to be called. And they called the blind man, saying to him, Be of good cheer, rise he calleth you.

And he, casting away his garment, rose, and came to Jesus.

And Jesus answered and said to him, What wilt thou that I should do unto you? The blind man said to Jesus, Lord, that I might receive my sight.

And Jesus said to him, Go your way; your faith has made you whole. And immediately he received his sight, and followed Jesus in the way.

Oh! What a joy! Blind Bartimaeus cried for mercy and the mercy of God prevailed for him. I remember when I was going through the valley of the shadow of death, there was a particular day, the situation was beyond description and life was going out of me. I was pinning away and then it occurred to me: you can cry out for the mercy of Jesus Christ! So, I called my daughter that was with me there and then. I told her, "Begin to cry for mercy." She began to cry, "Jesus, have mercy," and with the last bit of breath within me, I also began to cry for mercy and miraculously God intervened. Friend, you can always cry for mercy. The cry for mercy will always bring you your desired miracle. God did it for blind Bartimaeus; He did it in my own life. Your own testimony shall be the next in the name of Jesus Christ.

In Luke 4:31-37, there was a man that was demon-possessed that Jesus healed. This miracle is also recorded in Mark 1:21-28:

And Jesus came down to Capernaum, a city of Galilee, and taught them on the sabbath day.

And they were astonished at his doctrine: for his word was with power.

And in the synagogue there was a man, which had a spirit of an unclean devil, and cried out with a loud voice,

Saying, Let us alone; what have we to do with you, you Jesus of Nazareth? Are you come to destroy us? I know you who you are; the Holy One of God.

And Jesus rebuked him, saying, Hold your peace, and come out of him. And when the devil had thrown him in the middle, he came out of him, and hurt him not.

And they were all amazed, and spake among themselves, saying, What a word is this! for with authority and power he commands the unclean spirits, and they come out.

And the fame of him went out into every place of the country round about.

Right now as you read with me these healing miracles of Jesus Christ, there is power coming forth to you right there where you are. The same way Jesus commanded this devil to come out, the same way I command your liberty. I decree your freedom. I command that sickness to loose its grip off your body. Oh yes, God is performing something amazing in your life right now. Your testimony is hereby established in the name of Jesus Christ.

CHAPTER TWO

JESUS IN CONTROL OF NATURE

Jesus was even in control of nature. In Mark 4:37-39, Jesus calmed the storms. This account can also be found in Matthew 8:23-27 & Luke 8:22-25:

And there arose a great storm of wind, and the waves beat into the ship, so that it was now full.

And Jesus was in the hinder part of the ship, asleep on a pillow: and they awake him, and say to him, Master, care you not that we perish?

And Jesus arose, and rebuked the wind, and said to the sea, Peace, be still. And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm.

Yes, whatsoever is threatening your life right now, as far as your health is concerned, is the roaring of the sea. The same way Jesus rebuked the wind, I rebuke that sickness, I rebuke that disease. I rebuke that infirmity in your body. Jesus declared peace! The same way I declare peace over your health right now. I say, "Peace be still" to every roaring of the devil concerning your health, and I decree your liberty.

In Matthew 14, beginning from vs14, Jesus healed the sick and fed 5,000 men beside women and children. This miracle is also recorded in Mark 6: also in Luke 9 as well as John 6:

And Jesus went forth, and saw a great multitude, and was moved with compassion toward them, and he healed their sick.

And when it was evening, his disciples came to him, saying, This is a desert place, and the time is now past; send the multitude away, that they may go into the villages, and buy themselves victuals.

But Jesus said to them, They need not depart; give you them to eat.

And they said to him, We have here only five loaves, and two fishes.

Jesus said, Bring them here to me.

And he commanded the multitude to sit down on the grass, and took the five loaves, and the two fishes, and looking up to heaven, he blessed, and

brake, and gave the loaves to his disciples, and the disciples to the multitude.

And they did all eat, and were filled: and they took up of the fragments that remained twelve baskets full.

And they that had eaten were about five thousand men, beside women and children.

Jesus healed their sick and He also supplied their needs. Right now, your most important need is health and healing, and Jesus is supplying your need right now where you are.

In Matthew 14:22-32, Jesus even walked on the water. This miracle is also recorded in Mark's Gospel chapter 6 and also in John's Gospel, chapter 6:

And in the fourth watch of the night Jesus went to the disciples, walking on the sea.

And Peter answered him and said, Lord, if it be you, bid me come to you on the water.

And Jesus said, Come. And when Peter was come down out of the ship, he walked on the water, to go to Jesus.

But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save me.

And immediately Jesus stretched forth his hand, and caught him, and said to him, O you of little faith, why did you doubt? And when they were come into the ship, the wind ceased.

Oh! What a miraculous intervention! Peter walked on the water. The same way, I see you walking triumphantly out of that bed of affliction. However, the scripture records here that when Peter saw the wind, he became afraid. You must make sure that you do not give room to fear. Jesus saved Peter; He is right there to save you. But fear is the bait of the devil. He steals your miracles from you; so, refuse to give room to fear. See Jesus stretching forth His hands in your direction right now to save you.

In Mark 8:1-9, Jesus fed 4,000 people again. This account is also recorded in Matthew chapter 15:

Jesus said: I have compassion on the multitude, because they have now been with me three days, and have nothing to eat:

And his disciples answered him, From where can a man satisfy these men with bread here in the wilderness?

And Jesus commanded the multitude to sit down on the ground: and he took the seven loaves, and gave thanks, and brake, and gave to his disciples to set before them; and they did set them before the people.

And they had a few small fishes: and he blessed, and commanded to set them also before the people.

So they ate, and were filled: and they took up of the broken meat that was left seven baskets.

And they that had eaten were about four thousand: and he sent them away.

The key issue here again was compassion. Jesus said, "I have compassion." Because He had compassion, He provided what they needed. Oh! The compassion of Jesus is flowing in your direction right now, meeting you at the very point of your need. Praise God!

In Mark chapter 11, beginning from verse 12, Jesus cursed the fig tree and it withered. This account can also be found in Matthew 21:18-20:

And on the morrow, when they were come from Bethany, he was hungry:

And seeing a fig tree afar off having leaves, he came, if haply he might find any thing thereon: and when he came to it, he found nothing but leaves; for the time of figs was not yet.

And Jesus answered and said to it, No man eat fruit of you hereafter ***for ever. And his disciples heard it...***

And in the morning, as they passed by, they saw the fig tree dried up from the roots.

And Peter calling to remembrance said to him, Master, behold, the fig tree which you cursed is withered away.

And Jesus answering said to them, Have faith in God.

For truly I say unto you, That whosoever shall say to this mountain, Be you removed, and be you cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he said shall come to pass, he shall have whatsoever he said.

Therefore I say to you, What things soever you desire, when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you shall have them.

What a joy! Jesus cursed that fig tree from the root and the tree heard the cursing of Jesus and responded immediately. The same way, I curse that sickness in your body right now from the root and I decree your liberty. But friend, remember, Jesus said, "Have faith in God." The same way I say to you

today, have faith in God. Whatsoever you desire which I know right now is your healing, Jesus is delivering it to you right there where you are.

In John 2:1-11, Jesus turned water even into wine. In verse 11, the Bible says:

This beginning of miracles did Jesus in Cana of Galilee, and manifested forth his glory; and his disciples believed on him.

The same way, everything that is lacking in your health, Jesus is supplying it miraculously as you read by faith these scriptures. Remember, verse 11 says, Jesus manifested forth His glory through these miracles that He did. The same way, I see the glory of God being manifested forth in your life, by the miracle that Jesus is performing in your body right now.

CHAPTER THREE

JESUS RAISED THE DEAD!

What a joy! Even the dead were raised during the earthly healing ministry of Jesus Christ. So, I can say to you there is no closed case with God. There is no dead situation, as far as Jesus healing ministry is concerned. It doesn't matter how dead that situation might be concerning your health, the healing power of God is flowing right now.

In Luke 8:40-56, Jairus' daughter was miraculously raised from the dead

This miraculous healing is also recorded in Matthew 9; it can also be found in Mark 5:

And it came to pass, that, when Jesus was returned, the people gladly received him: for they were all waiting for him.

And, behold, there came a man named Jairus, and he was a ruler of the synagogue: and he fell down at Jesus' feet, and sought him that he would come into his house:

For he had one only daughter, about twelve years of age, and she lay a dying. But as he went the people thronged him (Jesus).

While Jesus yet spake, there comes one from the ruler of the synagogue's house, saying to him, Your daughter is dead; trouble not the Master.

But when Jesus heard it, he answered him, saying, Fear not: only believe, and she shall be made whole.

And when he came into the house, he suffered no man to go in, save Peter, and James, and John, and the father and the mother of the maiden.

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And Jesus put them all out, and took her by the hand, and called, saying, Maid, arise.

And her spirit came again, and she arose straightway: and he commanded to give her meat.

And her parents were astonished: but he charged them that they should tell no man what was done.

Oh! Halleluiah! The spirit of that little maid came again. I see your own spirit also being revived right now and coming back to life. Jesus is still at work in your body. Praise God!

In Luke 7:11-17, there was a widow at Nain whose son was raised back to life, during the earthly healing ministry of Jesus Christ.

And it came to pass the day after, that Jesus went into a city called Nain; and many of his disciples went with him, and much people.

Now when he came near to the gate of the city, behold, there was a dead man carried out, the only son of his mother, and she was a widow: and much people of the city was with her.

And when the Lord saw her, he had compassion on her, and said to her, Weep not.

And he (Jesus) came and touched the bier (coffin): and they that bare him stood still. And (Jesus) said, Young man, I say to you, Arise.

And he that was dead sat up, and began to speak. And he delivered him to his mother.

And there came a fear on all: and they glorified God, saying, That a great prophet is risen up among us; and, That God has visited his people.

Oh! What a joy! Jesus had compassion on that widow woman. The same way His compassion is reaching out to you right now. He said to her, “Weep not!” The same way, I say to you right now, “Weep not!” Your season of weeping is over! Jesus has prevailed in your situation and He is right now turning your mourning into dancing. Jesus also said to the dead man, “Arise!” The same way I say to you from that bed of sickness and affliction, “Arise!” God is visiting you right now. Oh! What a joy! Congratulations!

In John chapter 11, Lazarus was miraculously raised from the dead during the earthly ministry of Jesus Christ.

Now a certain man was sick, named Lazarus, of Bethany, the town of Mary and her sister Martha.

Vs 5

Now Jesus loved Martha, and her sister, and Lazarus.

Vs 17 says:

Then when Jesus came, he found that he had been lain in the grave for four days already...

Then said Martha to Jesus, Lord, if you had been here, my brother had not died.

Vs 38 says:

Jesus therefore again groaning in himself comes to the grave. It was a cave, and a stone lay on it.

Jesus said, Take you away the stone. Martha, the sister of him that was dead, said to him, Lord, by this time he stinks: for he has been dead four days.

Jesus said to her, Said I not to you, that, if you would believe, you should see the glory of God?

Then they took away the stone from the place where the dead was laid. And Jesus lifted up his eyes, and said, Father, I thank you that you have heard me.

And I knew that you hear me always: but because of the people which stand by I said it, that they may believe that you have sent me.

And when he thus had spoken, he cried with a loud voice saying, Lazarus, come forth.

And he that was dead came forth, bound hand and foot with grave clothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Then Jesus said to them, Loose him, and let him go.

Oh! Halleluia! This shall be your own testimony as well. Jesus loves you and He feels with you right now where you are. He is groaning on your behalf. The same way He commanded with a loud voice and said, "Lazarus come forth!" I command you right now to rise up from that bed of affliction. Jesus said to Lazarus and the people around, "Be loosed and then go free." The same way, I say to you, "Be loosed and begin to enjoy your freedom."

NOW, IT'S YOUR TURN!

Oh! Having read with me by faith in your heart, these miraculous healings that Jesus performed during His earthly ministry, I feel a tremendous urge and anointing right now in my spirit to pray for you right there where you are, concerning that situation of your health.

Oh friend, I like you to know that no matter what the situation may look like, there is a quickening power of God flowing to you right now. Just like Lazarus came out of the grave and was loosed, the same way, as you plug in your faith right now, you are coming out of that predicament free, liberated, delivered and completely made whole by the power of God.

So, now, I pray for you in the name of Jesus Christ, the name that is above every name and I curse every sickness and disease and torment and infirmity and plague in your body in the name of Jesus Christ! I command it to dry up from the roots, just like that fig tree dried up, and I decree your liberty! Just like Jesus commanded Lazarus to come forth, I also decree right now, begin to walk in health, in vitality, in vibrancy to the glory of God!

Freedom is your portion! Oh praise God. It is done! The things that you could not do before, begin to do them. Begin to move around. I see the quickening power of the Holy Spirit being released into your physical body right now.

Friend, God, who quickened my body by His Word and Spirit, is quickening yours right now. Thank You Father because it is done in Jesus' mighty name!

Remember, God is too faithful to fail! He is dependable and He is more than enough! I rejoice with you because there is no closed case with God.

Your testimony is sure! Congratulations!

SALVATION PRAYER
